## **Eligibility and Priorities for Participation by Leaders in Community-Based Early Childhood Education Settings**

The individuals listed below are eligible to participate in the Early Childhood Executive Leadership Institutes that are made available through the Pennsylvania Inspired Leadership Program of the Department of Education. While participants will not need to pay a fee to attend the Institute, they will have to pay their own travel and lodging expenses. The Institute is a professional development activity that meets the requirements for Act 48, Act 45, PQAS and the Pennsylvania Director Credential renewal credit for early childhood and school-age directors. Travel and lodging expenses may be paid out of professional development budgets line items of program budgets.
