Section: Overview of Transition

ransition to school is one of the most important steps in a young child's life. Children must learn to navigate academic, behavioral and social expectations that might be different from the expectations at home or in the early learning setting. Parents might feel discomfort and fear about sending their child into this new experience. Well planned, collaborative transition models build trust and relationships among children, families, teachers and the school community. Systematic strategies and common understanding of terms and approaches among stakeholders can increase the success of transition practices.

Robert Pianta and others at the National Center Early Development and Learning (NCEDL) describe an effective approach to enhancing children's transition into Kindergarten. This well-researched method provides a network of "social and information linkages that support children and families during the transition to school" (p.ix, Pianta and Kraft-Sayre, 2003). Effective transition plans should not be a one size fits all approach, but rather tailored to the needs of the individual communities.
