Follow these steps to receive PQAS credit after completing any of the free modules:

- You do not need to register for the module(s) in the PD Registry.
- Select the Health and Safety module or modules that interest you.
- After completing the module, you'll have access to a certificate.
- Within two weeks of completing the module, email your personalized certificate from the completed module(s) to LearnERS-PA@pakeys.org
 - **NOTE:** You will need to take a screenshot prior to printing or take a photo of your printed certificate(s).
- You must include your name and Registry ID number and the module certificate with your email.
- You can send more than one certificate in your email but only one person's information per email, please!
