During 2011, 2012, 2014, 2016, and 2017, OCDEL issued Certification Policy Announcements to reflect requirements for child care at the time of distribution.

This Announcement serves as communication that the following announcements will be obsolete, and when applicable updated announcements that replace them:

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- C-12-01: Proof of Identification Required for Child Care Center Directors and Group Child Care Home Primary Staff Person, issued September 18, 2012.

- C-14-03: Clarification Regarding Degrees Earned from Business, Technical, and Trade Schools, issued April 22, 2014.
